Holiness

- Definition "God's holiness means that He is separated from sin and devoted to seeking His own honor."
- Key Verses Exodus 15:11, Isaiah 6:1-7, Revelation 4:1-11, Exodus 19:4-6, 1 Peter 1:13-16, 2 Corinthians 6:16-7:1, Ephesians 5:25-27, Zechariah 14:20-21

Righteousness

- Definition "God's righteousness means that God always acts in accordance with what is right and is Himself the final standard of what is right."
- Key Verses Isaiah 45:19, Psalm 119:137-138, Romans 3:21-26,

Justice

- Definition "God establishes standards for His moral creatures that are in accord with His intrinsic holy moral nature and He judges His creatures by their conformity to those standards."
- Key Verses Deuteronomy, 2 Timothy 4:7-8, 2 Thessalonians 1:5-10

Peace / Order

- Definition "God's peace means that in God's being and in his actions he is separate from all confusion and disorder, yet he is continually active in innumerable well-ordered, fully controlled, simultaneous actions."
- Key Verses 1 Corinthians 14:33, Proverbs 3:17

Jealousy

- Definition "God's jealousy means that God continually seeks to protect his own honor"
- Key Verses Exodus 20:1-5

Wrathful

- Definition "God's wrath means that he intensely hates all sin."
- Key Verses John 3:36, Romans 1:18-32, Hebrews 1:8-9, 1 Thessalonians 1:9-10

Perfection

- Definition "God's perfection means that God completely possesses all excellent qualities and lacks no part of any qualities that would be desirable for Him."
- Key Verses Matthew 5:48

Glorious

- Definition "God's glory is the created brightness that surrounds God's revelation of Himself."
- Key Verses Exodus 34:29-35, Luke 2:9, Revelation 21:22-27, 2 Corinthians 3:18, Psalm 19
