Understand and Study the Bible Session 4: Understand and Study the Old Testament

Principles and Process

- Principle: Always remember where you are in the big story of the Bible!
- Principle: As you read and study, always ask how the passage points toward Jesus!
- Process:
 - 1. First and foremost, apply the process of reading carefully in context.
 - 2. Determine what response the passage called for at that time.
 - 3. Seek the Christ connection.
