

How To Memorize

1. Make up your mind that you can memorize just one verse - once you do one two is easier
2. Have a plan and work at it every day - make it a part of your routine
3. Read the memory verse in context and study it - learn what it means - read different translations
4. Write the verse several times - some find it helpful to associate a picture with a verse
5. Keep the current memory verse visible - on your screens, post-it notes, on the refrigerator, etc.
6. Repeat, Repeat, Repeat - say the verse aloud over and over
7. Learn the reference as part of the verse - putting it first usually works best
8. Use the verse - quote it to others, use it in your prayers
9. Review, often and regularly
10. Work with someone who will keep you accountable

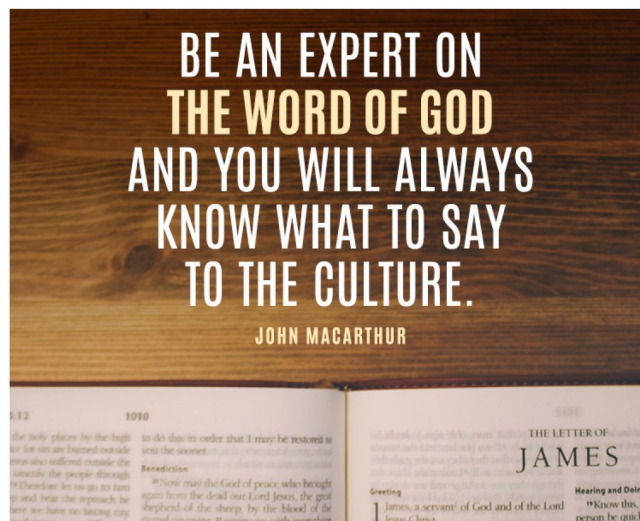
