Godly Management of Time

- We'll never really use the spiritual habits if we aren't disciplined in how we use our time!
- Use your time well for the days are evil (Ephesians 5:15-16)
- We will account for how we used our time (Romans 14:12, 1 Corinthians 3:12-15)
 - Use this time well to prepare for eternity (James 4:13-14)
 - We can't stop or reverse the flow of time, so put the past in the past and live intentionally for God's glory each day (Philippians 3:13-14)

Godly Management of Money

- How we use money reflects our spiritual maturity and godliness (Matthew 6:19-21)
- God owns everything (Psalm 24:1, Haggai 2:8)
 - We manage our money on God's behalf
 - We must provide for the needs of our families (1 Timothy 5:8)
 - Giving should be sacrificial, generous, joyful, voluntary, and cheerful (2 Corinthians 8-9)
- Giving to ministry is an act of worship (Philippians 4:18)
- Giving reflects our spiritual trustworthiness (Luke 16:10-13)
- Giving should be disciplined: planned and systematic (1 Corinthians 16:1-2)
