# **Reading Plans**

We believe spending time in God's Word daily is a critical activity for ALL Christians. If you are not already using a systematic reading plan, LRBC encourages you to try one of these:

### • A Year in the Bible

This is the easiest plan. While you will not read the entire Bible, each day you will read about one chapter starting in Genesis and working your way through Revelation. The passages are selected so that you will get a good overview of the message of the entire Bible even if you are unable to commit to one of the more time consuming reading plans

### • Read the Bible in 2 Years.

This is a slightly more challenging plan. Each day you will read about three chapters, including one from Psalms or Proverbs. In two years you will read the entire Bible and Psalms & Proverbs several times. This is a particularly good plan if you desire to read the Bible both mornings and evenings.

## • Read the Bible in a Year.

This is the most challenging plan. Each day you will read about 4 chapters starting in Genesis and working through Revelation. If you have done this in earlier years we suggest that you use a different translation this year.

Whichever plan you choose a new brochure will be available each month to provide the passages for the month.
