Reading Plans

We believe spending time reading God's Word daily is a critical discipleship activity for ALL Christians. For 2023 we are providing four plans for your consideration. If one of these does not meet your needs there are many more plans online or available in apps like "YouVersion." The important thing is to spend time in the Word daily.

Chronological Bible In a Year

This plan will take you through the entire Bible in the order in which events are believed to have happened. You will read approximately three chapters each day. This is the plan we recommend you use if at all possible.

Entire Bible In Two Years

This plan alternates readings from the Old and New Testaments in the order they appear in our Bible allowing you to read the entire Bible in two years by reading one or two chapters a day. The plan will continue in 2024.

New Testament in a Year

For those that are looking for a shorter reading plan this one will take you trough the entire New Testament in a year reading about one chapter a day. Would be a good addition to supplement the Family Reading Plan below.

Family Reading Plan

This plan presents a shorter passage of scripture that would be ideal for use in a family devotional setting or by children and youth. Each day's reading is usually a chapter or less; it can be read and discussed in less than 15 minutes.
