## Luke 5:27-32

Jesus in Galilo

<sup>27</sup> After this he went out and saw a tax collector named Levi, sitting at the tax booth. And he said to him, "Follow me." <sup>28</sup> And leaving everything, he rose and followed him.

<sup>29</sup> And Levi made him a great feast in his house, and there was a large company of tax collectors and others reclining at table with them. <sup>30</sup> And the Pharisees and their scribes grumbled at his disciples, saying, "Why do you eat and drink with tax collectors and sinners?" <sup>31</sup> And Jesus answered them, "Those who are well have no need of a physician, but those who are sick. <sup>32</sup> I have not come to call the righteous but sinners to repentance."

## Following → Feasting



Levi Answers the Call to Follow and Throws a Feast

- Jesus calls and Levi (Matthew) answers immediately! (verses 27-28)
- Levi throws a feast so other despised tax collectors could meet Jesus (verse 29)
- The Pharisees are quite upset by this! (verse 30)

## Following → Feasting



Jesus' Mission Is To Save Sinners Who Answer His Call

- Jesus seeks those desperate for a Savior (verses 31-32)
- His focus is on people who realize they're sinners rather than those who think they're fine
- We answer His call by believing and following Jesus

Your Following Should Reflect Jesus' Mission

- Levi illustrates true following life change and a passion to introduce others to Jesus
- Sometimes we love Jesus but still follow our preferences rather than His priorities
- We must connect with unbelievers and call them to faith and repentance in Jesus
