





One Final Meal Together

- Jesus Sacrificed His Broken Body for Us • Jesus blessed and broke bread (verse 19)
 - "This is my body, which is given for you. Do this in remembrance of me."
 - God's eternal Son took on a body so it could be broken on the cross for our sins

One Final Meal Together Jesus Shed His Blood to Establish the New

- Jesus blessed the cup (verse 20)
- "This cup that is poured out for you is the new covenant in my blood."
- Covenants were sealed by a blood sacrifice - this time God made the sacrifice
- This is the New Covenant of grace!
