Reading Plans

We believe reading God's Word daily is a critical discipleship activity for ALL Christians. For 2025 we are offering four plans you may want to consider. If one of these does not meet your needs, there are many more plans offered online or in apps like "YouVersion." The important thing is to spend time in the Word daily. In order of increasing difficulty, this year's plans are:

Family Reading Plan

This plan presents a shorter passage of scripture that would be ideal for use in a family devotional setting or by children and youth. Each day's reading is usually a chapter or less; it can be read and discussed in less than 15 minutes.

Navigator 5X5X5 Plan

With this plan you will read through the New Testament in about 5 minutes a day, 5 days a week – leaving the weekends open for catching up. The third "5" represent ways you can increase your understanding of the passage which can be found at navigators.org/resource/bible-reading-plans

Two Chapters a Day


With this plan you will have read the New Testament and Proverbs twice and the Psalms once during the year. This is a great plan for increasing your understanding of the New Testament.

M'Cheyne Bible Reading Plan

Originally developed by Scottish Pastor Robert Murray M'Cheyne this popular, but somewhat challenging, plan will have you reading about four chapters from different parts of the Bible each day so that by the end of the year you will have read the entire Old Testament once and the New Testament and Psalms twice.
